Purpose:

The T.E.A.C.H. Institute is an association of independent accredited home schools. We give encouragement and guidance to parents who want to be under legal authority and protection. Our service is to provide academic credibility to the education community and verify that these home educators are giving their children quality education.

Philosophy:

T.E.A.C.H. believes that God has given parents the authority to decide how their children are to be educated and the responsibility to see that this education is according to His unique design for each child. We recognize that parent's have the responsibility to determine how their children will receive this education. Parents also have a responsibility to assure society that their children are receiving an adequate education while they are being tutored at home. The T.E.A.C.H. Accrediting Association was developed to provide a structure to verify to the community and educational authorities that these children are being educated with excellence.

Policies:

In order that the family may achieve the greatest benefit from this program, the following specific guidelines have been designed for those accepted into T.E.A.C.H.

- A. Parents agree with the T.E.A.C.H. statement of faith. We are open to discuss any differences.
- B. Parents will cooperate with their home school consultant and maintain their accreditation status.
- C. Because of the emphasis on character development within T.E.A.C.H., we encourage both parents to attend the Institute in Basic Life Principles seminar. This seminar focuses on practical ways to train children in Godly character and teaches how to resolve family conflicts and maintain family harmony.
- D. Parents will agree to provide their children with supervised instruction for a minimum of 175 days per year.
- E. We encourage parents to be active Christians who manifest a growing relationship with Jesus Christ by having a Christian witness within their community.

Admission Guidelines:

- A. Applicants shall complete the family application form and return it to T.E.A.C.H. with the application fee. (Tuition payments may be arranged after admission into T.E.A.C.H.)
- B. Once the application has been received we will set up an interview.
- C. Upon completion of an application file (application, application fee, and an interview) the family will be officially admitted into TEACH and the accreditation process can begin.

TEACH Institute and Accreditation Services:

- 1. Monthly consultations with a TEACH certified Home Education Consultant.
 - These meetings are designed to verify academic progress, advise and encourage parents, and motivate students to perform at their highest level. Recommendations for academic improvement, personal character growth, and maintaining family relationships is given at these meetings. We are here to serve you so that you can achieve your goals. **Note:** Families hire their consultant from the TEACH pool of trained consultants.
- 2. Maintenance of student academic files, which will be forwarded if the student transfers to another school.
- 3. T.E.A.C.H. will verify your accreditation with a letter you may give to your district superintendent.
- 4. Administration of the Stanford Academic Achievement Test. Testing is required for all students, 1st 11th grade. TEACH administers this test in a group setting in the Spring (Test fee: \$35/student) The SAT, ACT, PSAT tests may be substituted for high schoolers.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT FEE

High School Fees: \$50/student/ year - \$100 maximum/ family/ year (\$5/ student/ month) Services include:

- A. T.E.A.C.H. will maintain and send, upon request, official high school transcripts (free of charge) to colleges, the military, employers, and scholarship organizations.
- B. Support Group for graduating high school students (including on-line web meetings)
- C. PSAT test administration (11th gr: Qualify for National Merit Scholarship, 10th gr: as practice test) (Test: \$25/student) Administered on Wed. Oct 16th
- D. PSEO guidance and planning starting in 10th grade for 11th and 12th grade enrollment
- F. Counseling for post high school preparation
- G. Letters of recommendation written for college and scholarship applications, employment and military.
- H. Verification of enrollment and GPA for insurance discounts.
- I. Planning and participation in the TEACH Institute high school graduation and baccalaureate ceremonies
- J. Accredited high school diploma upon meeting graduation standards

** CONSULTANT SERVICES: TEACH consultants are independent contractors and are hired independently by each family enrolled in TEACH and are paid directly for thier services.

□ Students Desiring to Graduate from TEACH:
Students planning to graduate from TEACH must have a TEACH consultant for a minimum of two years. Previous home schooled students will have to have high school records verified by two consultants, who will charge their hourly rate.
□ When Services Begin:
Consultant services will begin when initial payment has been made. Payment plans are available on monthly auto pay
basis. If tuition can be paid up front, it would be greatly appreciated.
□ Termination Policy:
In the case a tuition payment becomes 30 days overdue, please contact the office to make new arrangements. If no
arrangements are made, consulting services will have to be suspended.

□ Character Consulting:

Families, whose children are not being home schooled, may contract with TEACH consultants for character consultations with students and/ or their family.

STATEMENT OF FAITH
